



Core Values at Friends of the Family Ministries

Relationships. Our first priority. We build them and maintain them. We don't trash them for the sake of getting a job done. If faced with a choice between a relationship and a task, the relationship wins, within the bounds of our other core values.

Integrity. No pretense. We don't try to look or act like what we're not. We follow through with what we say we'll do. We get things done on time. We pay our bills on time. We don't manipulate others.

Service. We're here to help. We greet people warmly in person and on the phone. Our stance toward others is how to benefit them, not ourselves. We're not possessive of or protective of our piece of the ministry pie. Instead, we endeavor to give ministry away, to equip others, to multiply ourselves.

Confidentiality. What gets said here stays here. Clients must have confidence that we will keep their private stuff private. The only exceptions are noted in our consent form.

Accountability. Our financial records are open to all ministry partners (mps). We provide an annual financial report and budget to all mps. Designated gifts are spent on what they were designated for, or are returned to the donor, or are spent on other things only with the donor's consent. We don't spend funds we don't have and then beg to be bailed out.
