Duties

- Network with area pastors, counselors and social service agencies to discover niches of need that Friends of the Family might be able to meet.
- Work collegially with the Executive Director and other staff.
- Pursue continuing education appropriate for the position.

- Master's degree in Marriage and Family Therapy, Counseling Psychology, or equivalent. Evidence of biblical and theological education in coursework.
- Trained and skilled in play therapy with children.
- Supervised internship and/or field experience.
- Licensure as LPC or LMFT, or registered as a Registered Intern, required.

- Spiritually mature Christian.
- Personal and family life that represent our ministry well.
- Active member of a local evangelical church.
- Possesses a strong vision for and passion about our ministry.
- Embraces the mission and values of Friends of the Family.
- Seeks a ministry with a balance of preventative and therapeutic emphases.
- Envisions a long-term commitment to the position.
